A Word From The President

Many thanks to all of you who attended the Spring Membership meeting last Saturday. We had approximately 50 members in attendance, and an equal number of proxies representing the wishes of those who could not make it. The Bylaws amendment modifying the Corporate membership category passed, increasing the number of Sponsored Members from four to five. She and her committee have done a great job with the new site and have set the stage for our new internet-based 2017 marketing plan.

The concept has been approved, and we should see the fruits of their labor soon. Many thanks to all involved for the hard work over the last six months.

Finally, we are rapidly approaching the Member Guest Tournament, August 3 – 6 this year. I encourage you to participate in this always popular event and bring someone who might become a new member. We are reminded that the club will sell itself – but we have to get those potential new members here to see what we have to offer.

Tip of the Month - Reminder Hole #13 Local Rule Addition

Due to balls collecting in a small area with numerous divots, the following rule will apply.

A ball lying in a closely mown area through the green (fairway height or less) may be lifted, without penalty, and cleaned. The ball must be marked before lifted and placed within one club length no nearer the hole.

Reminder - Pace of Play

As we are getting into our busy season and play is picking up just a reminder of pace of play. We want everyone to enjoy their round of golf but also not to feel pushed or held up. While you are in your round try to always pay attention to other golfers on the course around you. If you feel that you are being pushed just let the group behind you play through. When you complete a hole and get to the next tee go ahead and tee off and then let the group behind play through. We want everyone to enjoy their time on the course so pay attention to your surroundings and let faster players play through.
